

Windows XP Drive Mapping Solution



There is a bug with Windows XP regarding drive mappings and mounting the OHP6000 drives. If two continuous drive letters are not available only one drive gets mounted and the other is missing.

Example:

A: Floppy

B: Reserved

C: Internal Hard rive

D: CDROM

E: Available

F: Mapped Network Drive

G-Z: Available

In this drive mapping sequence the player will get one drive mounted to E and the other would be missing because the first two consecutive drive letters are not available.

Solution: for this example would be to re-map the F: drive to G making E: and F: available for the 6000 Series Player. To remap a drive, please refer to Windows online help guide.
